



Motozone in Tigerton rolls out new track/layout for 2015 AMA Amateur National Loretta Lynn Area Qualifier

Heavy equipment recently moved in on the terrain at the Motozone in Tigerton, Wisconsin for a complete track rebuild. Professional track builder Marty Leum moved enormous amounts of dirt over the course of three days to give the Motozone a fresh start and new beginnings as the 2015 race season approaches.

Every single obstacle on the track has been either changed or rebuilt and reshaped. At least half of the track has been rerouted for an all new experience. It's nearly impossible to build a track for all skill levels but Marty did an outstanding job of building "sections" of track that would appeal to different skill sets. New rhythm sections will challenge A riders and aspiring professionals while simple elevated corners and off-cambers will give the youth and beginner riders a fun and enjoyable change.

The dirt is going to take a while to settle back in place, but that should also work to provide a nice rough track for the Loretta Lynn AMA Amateur National Championship Area Qualifier coming up May 1-3, 2015. If you've been to Loretta Lynn's you know how rough that track gets, the Motozone should give racers that same experience and provide them with an excellent gauge to determine how prepared they are to compete at the AMA Amateur National Championships in early August.

The Motozone has a number of great events lined up this summer in addition to the Area Qualifier including the \$6000 Pro Am weekend between the Red Bud and Millville Pro Nationals July 11th & 12th. The first race of the "Tweener" Pro AM will be held at Valley Raceway in Crystal Falls, MI – just two hours up the road from Tigerton on Saturday July 11th and then things move South to Tigerton for Sundays Pro AM on July 12th. August 28-30th the Motozone will debut its soon to be built supercross track. The "Battle of Wisconsin" will feature Friday night Supercross, Saturday outdoor practice and Sunday Moto to determine the best of the best (and it's the weekend before the Baja Brawl in nearby Michigan). We end our season with the "Showdown at Sundown" best whip weekend which is becoming a can't miss event featuring pit bike racing under the lights, bras and panties racing, goon riding state championships and a great best whip contest under the lights, and of course great practice and racing on the motocross track the weekend of September 18-20th, 2015.
